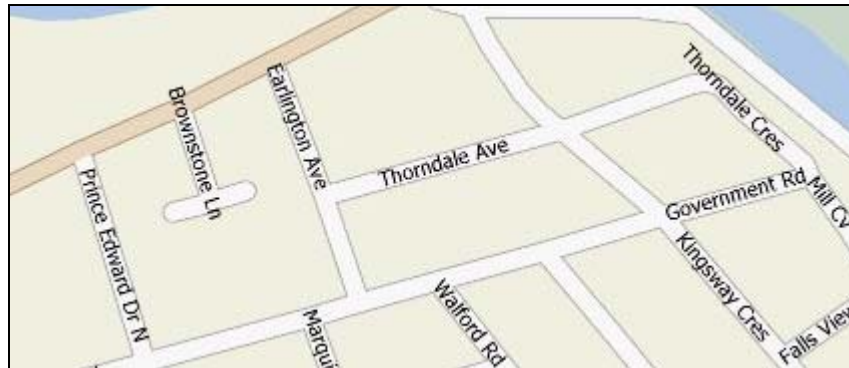


## Reconstruction of Earlington Avenue and Thorndale Avenue

### Public Open House

Beginning in May 2008, the City of Toronto, West District will be carrying out road reconstruction for Earlington Avenue from Government Road to Dundas Street West, and for Thorndale Avenue from Earlington Avenue to Thorndale Crescent. The project will include sanitary system replacement, watermain system replacement and new storm sewer. The roads will be rebuilt with curb and gutter and existing sidewalks replaced. The existing road and underground services have reached an age where renewal is required. **(See map below).**



### Design Details

The following work to be carried out as part of this project includes:

- Reconstruction of Earlington Avenue and Thorndale Avenue with curb and gutter;
- Sidewalk replacement;
- Replacement of sanitary sewers and services,
- New storm sewer system and catchbasins,
- Replacement of watermain and services.

The project team will be present to explain the traffic management plan, construction staging, and answer any questions you may have about the project.
