No. 1985-48

To appoint Executive Directors in the Parks and Recreation Services Department, the Personnel Department and the Works Department.

No. 1985-49

A By-Law to establish certain lands as Public Highways - forming part of Bloor Street West, Broadfield Drive and Markland Drive.

No. 1985-50

A By-Law to establish certain lands as a Public Highway - forming part of Fairfield Avenue, City of Etobicoke.

No. 1985-51

A By-Law to establish certain lands as a Public Highway forming part of Edenbridge Drive, City of Etobicoke.

No. 1985-52

To Levy an Annual Tax on Telephone Company doing business in the City of Etobicoke.

No. 1985-53

To amend Chapters 320 and 324, Site Specifics, of the Zoning Code and By-Law #1981-117 with respect to certain lands located on the north side of Old Mill Road, opposite the Old Mill Restaurant, south and west of the Humber River. (Application to permit a parking lot.)

No. 1985-54

To amend Chapter 143, Flood Hazard areas of the Code of the Corporation of the City of Etobicoke with respect to certain lands located on the north side of Old Mill Road, opposite the Old Mill Restaurant, south and west of the Humber River. (Exempt lands from Flood Hazard Control Areas in order that the lands may be utilized for service automobile parking for the Old Mill Restaurant.)

Separate School representation on the Board of Education for the City of Etobicoke.
